#### **New Business**

- Coronation Bid
  - Joe made a motion that a Coronation bid committee be established to independently submit a bid for coronation. The motion was seconded and voted upon and unanimously approved.
  - (Rhode) I've called and spoken to about 30 sites from varying peoples suggestions, both in and out Barony. There is one very viable one in Middletown that sounds like it'll fit the bill. They have asked me to go meet them in person and talk to them about our needs and see the site. I have given them some dates I'm available, and will report back.
    - I have a few more sites to give a shout to.
- It has been suggested that there be either an information session or a handout describing the offices, what is expected and how to get things done (requesting equipment etc)
  - It would be great if someone with some experience in this would work on setting this up.
- Storage: We should evaluate whether or not we want to move storage sites and consider purchasing a trailer and where to keep it.
  - Storage unit now month to month, so it's just a matter of deciding if there is a site that better suits our needs..
- An updated inventory is needed
  - Martial loaner (Archery & Rattan)
    - Rapier inventory has been received.

- Baronial Coronet Polling Calendar (Christoffel/Joan)
  - Approve the Ballot
    - Two ballot forms were proposed. The single choice and multiple choice ballots. The single choice was voted upon and approved by the members present.

  - July 1 (Before Pennsic) Request the Zip Code List & Mailing Labels
    - Zip Code List passed to EK Seneschal
  - August 10 (immediately after Pennsic) Mail Ballots
  - August 20 Send the ballots out
  - October 1 (30 to 45 days from Ballot Mailing) Polling period ends
  - November 1 Tally Period should be done. (Tallies should be sent to the Crown)
  - December 1 Crown Decision should take no more than a month (hopefully)
  - February 23 Investiture
