### Officers Reports

- *Archery - Casmir*
  - Archery Practices continue and I would encourage all to attend. I would like to make a suggestion of a change to the custom. As Archery Marshal having the elections in June are inconvenient. I would make a motion to change them to March.
  - I have some corrections to the Pennsic Archery Rules
  - Populace Archery War Point Shoot There are now 4 populace shoots and you can shoot each one up to 5 times (Yes, that is TWENTY rounds of Pennsic populace archery for everyone!).
  - Format: The Pennsic Populace Archery War Point consists of four separate shoots, each shoot is worth 1 war point for a total of 4 war points. The winner of each shoot is determined by total number of points tallied by archers over the course of the War. Scores will be tallied each day and posted in the Marshals Tent. Any member of the populace may participate.
  - Description: There are 4 parts to the populace shoot:
  - Castle Clout Shoot (1 Point): The target is a simulated castle turret. Archers will be shooting at about 100 yards into a square of approximately 27 feet by 27 feet giving an approximate area of 729 square feet. There will be a moat monster protecting the castle in front at about 50 yards. This is an untimed shoot; archers are allowed 6 arrows or bolts. Scoring for this shoot is as follows:
    - 1 point for inside the moat 2 points for hitting the moat monster 3 points for inside the castle 4 points for hitting objects inside the castle
  - Soldier Shoot (1 Point): The archers will shoot 6 arrows or bolts, untimed, at the soldiers that are invading. These targets will be set at approximately 15 yards, 35 yards, 45 yards and 55 yards. Any arrow or bolt hitting the painted portion of the target scores as follows:
    - 1 point for the 15-yard target 2 points for the 35-yard target 3 points for the 45-yard target 4 points for the 55-yard target
  - Castle Window Shoot (1 Point): Archers will shoot 6 arrows or bolts, untimed, at a castle window located between 25 and 35 yards. The castle window will be at

least 8 inches wide and 36 inches tall. There will be an object inside the castle window. Scoring will be as follows: 1 point for each arrow or bolt inside the castle window, 2 points for each arrow or bolt inside the object in the castle window

- Friend/Foe Shoot (1 Point): This will be a 30 second timed shoot at an image of two opposing fighters or adversaries. One fighter will be designated as the "Friend"; and one as the "Foe". Archers will be shooting from between 20 and 25 yards and will have 30 seconds to safely shoot as many arrows/bolts as they can. The marshal will give a "5, 4, 3, 2, 1, Loose!" command at the beginning and then a "5, 4, 3, 2, 1, Hold!" command at the end. Scoring will be as follows:
  - 2 points for each arrow/bolt striking the "Foe" target. -1 point for each arrow/bolt striking the "Friend" target. 0 points for arrows/bolts that strike neither. Archers will have 30 seconds to safely shoot as many arrows or bolts as they can
- **Exchequer** - *Llewelwyn/Tristan*
  - We currently have \$18,858.81 in the bank account.
  - I have purchased the new checks and they have arrived but I have not been charged for them yet.
  - I'm still looking for a deputy. Please contact me if you are interested.
- **Fencing** - *Catalina*
  - Fencing continues to go well. I have made a few posts to the DSH FB page on some updates for the fencing war points at pennsic this year. It's important that fencers check out the rules for war this as things have changed compared to previous years. Otherwise they can check out the EK rapier page for more details: <https://rapier.eastkingdom.org/2019/05/>. The kingdom marshal of fence has put out the call for marshals to volunteer at the rapier field for at least some portion of time at War.
  - Llewellyn and I have been wicked busy with the farm so we haven't had a chance to get the storage shed yet although we plan to grab it tomorrow if possible. We'll just need to figure out when people can show up to practice super early so we can set it up.

  - **Order of St. Martin** - Azure, on a sun argent a capital letter M azure.
  - **Worshipful Company of Artificers** - (Fieldless) In saltire a pair of scissors and a smith's hammer argent.
  - **Order of the Keel** - Per fess wavy azure and barry wavy argent and azure, a hulk Or and in chief two clouds argent.
