Officers Reports

- **Archery** - *Casimir*
 - Attended a Pennsic Archery Co-Ordinator's meeting. Plan to start Archery practice This month I have contacted Joe and Alice they continue to be willing to host practice. The range is clear and available for use.
- **Exchequer** - *Maria/Llewellyn*
 - Our budget balance is \$15164.12
 - The \$18 check for the heraldry still has not been cashed, and I haven't heard from kingdom about last year's end of year report.
 - There has been no activity in my realm since the storage unit payments.

 - Discussions about beginning practices again. Probably at Wharton Brook State Park again. Once the marshals in charge are fully vaccinated , they will feel safer running practices.  - Going to be virtual this year so A&S Classes are expected to be scheduled online. I'll try to pass along the details on classes as they become available.
- In Other News:
 - The Atwater Library (North Branford) and Smith Library (Northford) are not yet allowing use of their community and meeting rooms. They normally are closed on Sundays for the warm weather months but I hope that by the time they have Sunday hours again, we will be past the plague and they will again allow use of their space. The library itself is open to the book-loving public, just not the meeting rooms.

- **Social Media Officer- Kit**
 - Sent in quarterly report to EK.
 - Facebook groups are changing the categories of groups: public, private, hidden.
 - Public: anyone can write and read posts, you can search and find the group.
 - Private: reading and posting is limited to members only, you can search and find the group. This is what SCA requires.
 - Hidden: only members can read and write posts. You can't find the group if you search for it unless you are already a member.
 - Christoffel: Barony group was made private but it can take Facebook three days to activate the change. Christoffel suggested setting up a "Fan Page" for the barony where there are a limited number of people who can post but that the public can read the posts – it would be a public (not private) group.
 - Kit: a "Fan Page" might be problematic and makes more work.
 - Catalina: Dragonship Haven Fencing page is already set to Private. No idea if heavy list was changed to Private.
 - NO POSTING ABOUT ARMISTACE IN BARONY PAGE IS ALLOWED.

 - The big news: Pennsic is officially postponed.
 - The Coopers are planning a medieval fair. It is not an SCA event. The Kingdom Seneschal has asked us not to advertise it on "Official" pages to prevent confusion about it not being an SCA event.
 - Re-opening guidelines for events & practices
 - Masks always

- No food to be provided either by event staff or attendees to other attendees
 - Social distancing when eating
 - All events to be outdoors, NO CAMPING
 - Max attendance of 150 people (staff included)
 - Pre-registration and contact tracing is required
 - There is no end date on this so it is indefinite until the BOD & Kingdom decide to re-visit the guidelines.
