I have also served as the Majordomo for a number of the Crowns of the East, and on multiple occasions, managed the operations for the East Kingdom Royal encampment at Pennsic.

I believe that the role of the baronial coronet is to be the eyes, ears, and hands of the Crown of the East within the Barony and to partner with other regional groups in the East to the benefit of all parties.
